We are seeking to hire a **Part-Time Shuttle Driver** at our Nampa Medical Center, to provide high quality grocery shuttle services for individuals in need.

If hired, you will give passengers to and from the grocery store, picking them up and dropping them off along a predetermined route. You will need to keep the shuttle vehicle clean, do basic maintenance checks and report any irregularities. You will also be asked to keep an accurate account of all passengers picked-up and delivered using paper or electronic data collection devices.

You will need to know how to operate handicap lift equipment for wheelchair accessibility and be able to assist passengers as needed. In addition, you need to know how to change a flat tire and perform basic vehicle maintenance checks

About This Position:

Our Shuttle runs every other Saturday, with an approximately 6-hour shift (9:30 to 3:30 p.m.). We also operate for a few hours, every other Wednesday, to take passengers to collect food boxes. Please be aware that schedules can change depending on demand.

Safety is essential in this role and we expect our drivers to obey all traffic rules and regulations while operating the shuttle. You will need to be able to read a map and/or street finder guides, and handle stressful situations related to weather conditions, traffic and on-demand customer pick-up requests.

REQUIREMENTS

Education:

- High School Diploma or equivalent preferred

Experience:

- One to two years' shuttle experience preferred
- Bilingual (Spanish speaking) is highly preferred

Licenses:

- Class C CDL or higher required
- Must have active driving privileges. *If, during the course of employment, driving privileges change or colleague receives a driving citation, the colleague is required to notify their supervisor and/or HR.*
