

Absentee voting allows you to vote if you are out of town on Election Day or prefer to vote from the comfort of your home. Any registered voter in Idaho may request an absentee ballot to be mailed to their address.

REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

1. Make sure you are registered to vote. You must be registered to vote in Idaho to request an absentee ballot.
2. Complete the absentee ballot request form. An online request form is available at voteidaho.gov.
3. Select which elections in the current year you'd like to receive an absentee ballot.
4. For applications through the online request form, provide your state-issued ID and the last four digits of your social security number. We use your Idaho state-issued ID and the last four digits of your Social Security Number to match your absentee ballot request with your signed voter registration form. *No scanning of your ID or Social Security Card is necessary.*

You must complete a new absentee ballot request form each calendar year.

Absentee ballots must be requested more than eleven (11) days before an election

ONCE YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT ARRIVES

- ✓ You will receive instructions, a secrecy sleeve, and a return envelope with the ballot.
- ✓ Follow the instructions carefully. Mark your ballot using a blue or black ink pen (avoid highlighters and markers like Sharpies!) and fill in the box or oval completely.
- ✓ Pay attention to ballot instructions and vote only for the appropriate number of candidates in each race.
- ✓ Remember to sign the outside of the return envelope. All signatures will be verified by elections staff.
- ✓ Add the required postage to the return envelope if mailing.
- ✓ Return the completed ballot by mail, to an official elections drop box, or your county elections office by 8 p.m. on Election Day for your vote to be counted.
